CLASS NEWS

Class 1

Wow! What a productive week we have had in Class 1. We have been counting, and ordering numbers in Numeracy. In Literacy, we have been writing sections of our class book 'Simon Sock' and acting out the plot. In R.E, we have been learning all about the 'Creation Story' and what happened on each day. In Art, we have been learning all about different lines, and experimenting in chalk, both in our books and on the playground. This week, Reception children have also finished their first set of phonemes, and have been given their first reading book with text in. Thank you to all those parents who attended the reading meeting on Thursday, I hope you found it useful. Have a great weekend everyone!

Class 2

This week we have read to the end of our story, 'Tidy', and really enjoyed the message the story relates. We have been looking at the story from Pete's point of view and thinking about what he learns through the story. We have been working hard to learn more times tables and our spellings which relate to our Phonics work this week. We are looking at what is meant by a Monarchy, and identifying Kings and Queens in recent history. In our R.E. Work we are focussing on The Creation Story, thinking about our gratitude to God for all he created, and about our responsibility to take care of his world. We are making good progress with our ukelele playing and we are enjoying our lessons with Mr. Henderson.

Class 3

This week has flown by in Class Three! We have been carrying out lots of activities linked to rounding and partitioning numbers in maths. The children have been working hard to consolidate their understanding. We have been answering questions linked to our guided reading texts and trying to refer to the story to offer detailed responses. In science we have been looking at teeth and what different teeth are used for. All the children enjoyed their first swimming session and are making great progress. All children are today taking login details home to access our new app 'Seesaw'. This will allow the children to share some of the activities they carry out in class and talk about their learning. Dojo will still be used for news and sharing information. Have a fantastic weekend everybody!

Class 4

Another very busy week in Class 4. We have been focusing on columnar addition and subtraction in maths, looking at word problems towards the end of the week. We have been reading more of our class text 'The Wizards of Once', looking at the different characters and the events that have occurred so far. We have also been busy starting swimming lessons, considering respect in PSHE and looking at a piece of poetry which links to God being 'the creator' in RE.
