Class 1

What an unusual week! The snow provided lots of opportunities, in our outdoor learning sessions, for lots of imagination, co-operation, improving gross and fine motor skills, along with learning about the weather and seasons in Science. The children then wrote about their morning, and produced some excellent accounts and illustrations. This week, Reception have been investigating amounts of more than and fewer than. Year 1 have been matching digits to words in Numeracy, and looking at ways to represent numbers with resources e.g Numicon, ten frames, etc. Year 1 homework has been sent home for a test on Monday. In P.E, the children have been experimenting with different ways of travelling across the hall, using different parts of the body. In R.E, we have begun learning about 'The Nativity'. For the school carol concert, we have been given roles of angels and sheep. Please look out on Dojo, to see which costume your child will require. Many thanks.
