CLASS NEWS

Class 1

What a wonderful start to the term we have had! It has been lovely to welcome our new Reception to the class, and see how quickly they have settled in. We have spent time this week learning new routines, finding our way around the school, and more importantly making new friends. Next week, Reception will be having their 'Baseline Assessments', which are required by the government. All Reception children have been sent home with the relevant information for parents. It has been really great to see Year 1 children really step up this week, guiding the younger children and taking on more responsibility in class. Next week, we will begin our theme for this half-term, 'All about me'. Have a wonderful weekend everyone!

Class 2

Class 2 have made a really positive start to the new school year! We have spent time getting used to our new class, with its freshly painted walls and new carpet. The classroom looks and feels very different. We have got most of our new exercise books and made a start on our new topics in most subjects. We have new spelling books which will be brought home in rucksacks, together with times tables books. Some children have 5 spellings to learn and others have 10. We will have a test every Wednesday. Year 2 children are starting to learn the Ten Times Table, and Year 3 children are continuing from last year with a little revision on the 3 and 4 Times Tables. The children need to make sure they have their test books in their bags ready for tests on Wednesday. Please come and talk to us if you have any concerns about spellings and times tables tests. Have a great weekend everyone!

Class 3

We have all had a fantastic start to the new school year in Class Three. All the children have come back to school extremely enthusiastic and have all had a very good first week, well done everybody! It has been great to see how quickly the children have adapted to being in a year four classroom and I am extremely proud of them all! We have been developing our understanding of place value and partitioning on maths and focusing on noun phrases in English. In science the children have been learning about the human digestive system. The week has been capped off with a fabulous visit to Bangor Races where the children took part in a number of challenging maths activities throughout the day. The day was enjoyed by all. Class 4

A big welcome back to all Class 4. It has been lovely to see you all again this week and hear all about your summer holidays. As Year 5 and 6, we have been speaking a lot this week about responsibilities and Year 6 have been given their monitor roles across the school. We have also started lots of work in class. We have looked more at place value in maths this week, looking at rounding to the nearest 10, 100, 1000, 10,000, 100,000 and 1,000,000!! In English, we have predicted what we think our new class text 'The Wizards of Once' is about and we have had a great discussion in our science lesson this week about our new topic 'circulation and health.' This term, our PE days are Monday and Tuesday. Please can all students have their PE kits in school for Monday. I will also issue homework from next week.
