Dear Parent/Carer,

On Wednesday afternoons, starting next week, Class 3 pupils will begin their 5 week block of Forest School sessions. These will occur on a weekly basis until Wednesday 5th March.

We would be grateful if you could ensure that your child brings the following clothing to school in a robust bag or rucksack to wear during these lessons.

- a pair of wellies,
- thick socks
- a pair of old trousers or leggings
- warm jumper(s)
- waterproof trousers or ski pants
- warm waterproof coat
- woolly hat
- pair of gloves
- scarf

If your child does not have a pair of waterproof trousers, we do have some in school that he/she could use.

Please ensure that all Forest School clothing is named and placed in a bag and brought in each Wednesday for the sessions.

We ensure that children have a biscuit and a drink when they are actively participating in Forest School activities. As this has a funding implication, we would ask for a voluntary contribution of £2 per child to cover the cost. This can be paid using ParentPay.

Please also use ParentPay to give consent for your child to take part in the sessions which include:

- Forest School sessions, including sessions where a small fire will be lit and cooking activities may occur.
- Cooking and tasting of foods at Forest School (e.g. toast, marshmallows etc). Usually, hot chocolate and a biscuit are provided as a snack during sessions.

Please complete your consent through ParentPay by end of Tuesday 28th January.
